## Environmental Services

### Free Tipping Fee Voucher Program

The City of Temiskaming Shores is introducing a Free Tipping Fee Voucher Program. The purpose of this program is to provide residential taxpayers the opportunity to take advantage of free tipping fees at the New Liskeard Landfill. The Free Tipping Fee Voucher Program will be replacing the bi-annual Amnesty Program.

### Voucher Guidelines

- ◆ Each residence is entitled to 2 free vouchers on an annual basis
- ◆ Each voucher is valid for 2 cubic yards of waste (equivalent to one 1/2 ton truckload)
  - ◆ The appropriate tipping fee will apply for all loads exceeding this amount
  - ◆ Tipping fees remain applicable for prohibited waste
  - ◆ Surcharge fee remains applicable for white goods containing freon gas or ozone depleting substance
- ◆ Vouchers are valid anytime throughout the calendar year

### Voucher Qualifications

- ◆ Must be a resident of the City of Temiskaming Shores
- ◆ Residents are to supply a copy of their tax bill or a letter of authorization from the taxpayer/landlord to obtain the vouchers
- ◆ CI establishments are not eligible

### Voucher Location

- ◆ Vouchers are to be picked up at City Hall, 325 Farr Drive, Haileybury
- ◆ A copy of the tax bill or letter of authorization will be required

To minimize the risk of fire and burn injury, the fire service recommends the following cottage fire safety tips:

Install smoke alarms on every storey and outside all sleeping areas. It's the law for all Ontario homes, cottages, cabins and seasonal homes to have working smoke alarms on every storey and outside all sleeping areas.

- Test smoke alarms at least monthly or each time you return to the cottage. Pack a new smoke alarm and extra smoke alarm batteries in case they need replacement.
- Install and ensure carbon monoxide alarms in your cottage if it has a fuel-burning appliance.
- Develop and practice a home fire escape plan to ensure everyone knows what to do if the smoke alarm sounds.
- Know the telephone number for the local fire department and your cottage's emergency sign number, in case of emergency.
- Clean barbecues before using them. Keep an eye on lit barbecues and ensure all combustibles, as well as children and pets are kept well away from them. Fires can happen when barbecues are left unattended.
- Keep barbecue lighters and matches out of sight and reach of children.
- Remember to bring a flashlight with extra batteries.
- Check heating appliances and chimneys before using them.
- Check with your local fire department, municipality, or Ministry of Natural Resources to determine whether open air burning is permitted before having a campfire or burning brush. If open burning is allowed, fires should be built on bare soil or on exposed rock. Remove leaves and twigs from around the fire to keep it from spreading. Always keep a bucket of water, sand, or even a shovel close by and supervise the fire at all times.
- If you must smoke, do so outside. Keep a large can with water nearby so cigarette butts can be safely discarded. If you drink, do so responsibly. Tobacco use and excessive alcohol consumption are contributing factors in many fires and can lead to serious injuries.
- Burn candles in sturdy candleholders that will not tip and are covered with a glass shade. When you go out, blow out!

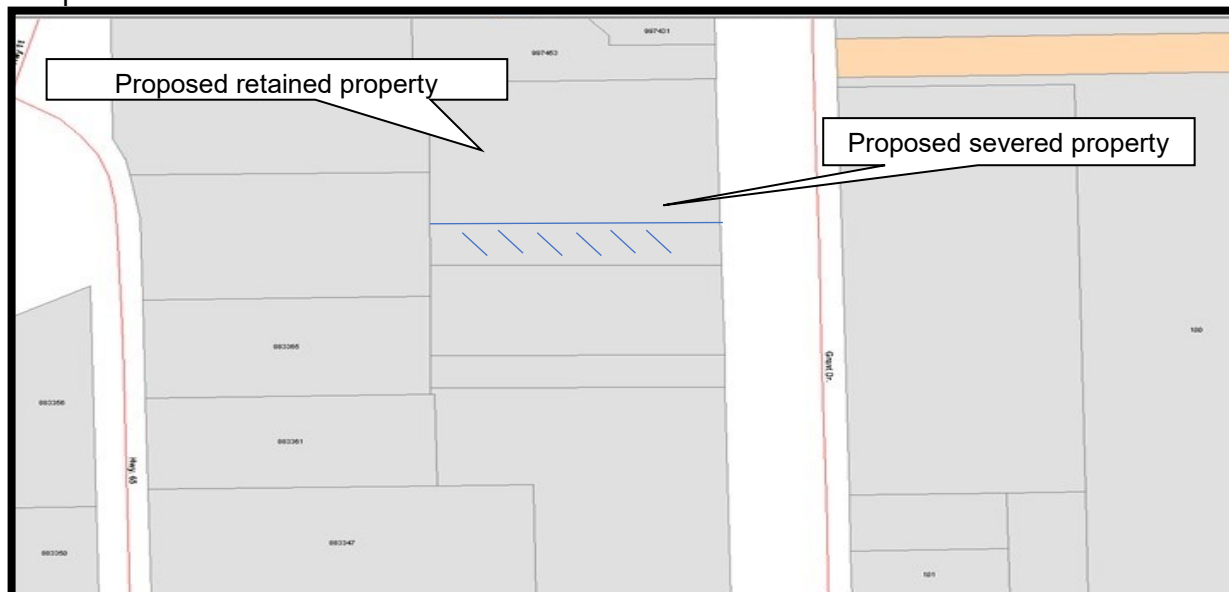

## Transportation

### Decommissioning Winter Operations

The winter season has come to an end and city staff are performing tasks to decommission winter operations. Thank you for your cooperation in helping keep our streets clear and safe this Winter Season.

#### Complete

**Overnight Parking Prohibited** | November 1, 2023 to March 31, 2024

**Winter Maintenance Season** | November 1, 2023 to April, 2024.

#### In Effect

**Weather Monitoring Season** | October 1 to April 30.

The minimum standard is to monitor the weather, both current and forecast to occur in the next 24 hours, once every shift or three times per calendar day, whichever is more frequent, at intervals determined by the municipality.

### Half Load Restrictions in Effect

March 6, 2024 until June 30, 2024, unless indicated otherwise.

When half-load restrictions are in effect, a road is off-limits to vehicles exceeding 5 tonnes per axle. However, there may be alternate routes that can be taken to reach a destination.

#### Why

Roads become softer and weaker during the spring thaw. Heavy vehicle traffic on these roadways can cause permanent damage. Following the half-load restrictions reduces the potential for any unnecessary road repairs or reconstruction.

### Street Sweeping and Spring Clean-up

The annual spring clean-up includes sweeping all paved roads and some hard surfaces, to remove debris and materials that have accumulated throughout the winter season and could pose dangers to motorists, pedestrians/cyclists as well as clogging up catch basins and inlets.

Residents are asked to help crews clean the city by not parking vehicles on the streets while street sweeping activities are being conducted in the area. Typical hours of operations are Monday to Friday, between 6:30am and 3pm beginning in April (weather dependent). Hours of operation may also vary depending on the location that needs to be swept.

## Public Works Services

### Hydrant Flushing | April 2024

Hydrant Flushing is conducted semi-annually as part of the Water Maintenance Program. These operations are carried out typically in April and October of each year.

During this time customers may experience discolored water. If you do, it would be advisable to refrain from doing laundry or using hot water until the water clears. The Public Works Operations Staff makes every effort to maintain the designated schedule. Your co-operation is appreciated.

### Temiskaming Shores OPP Detachment Board

Pursuant to the Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019, the City of Temiskaming Shores is inviting applications from community members to join the Temiskaming Shores OPP Detachment Board.

The Board, which represents the City of Temiskaming Shores, includes two (2) elected officials, two (2) community members and one (1) provincial appointee. Currently, we are seeking applications to fill **one (1) community member appointment**. The term of this appointment will expire in the Fall of 2026.

#### Eligibility Requirements:

**To become a Community Appointee, you must:**

- ◆ Be an eligible elector in the City of Temiskaming Shores
- ◆ Obtain and maintain a current and acceptable Criminal Record Check, at your expense, prior to appointment to the Board; and
- ◆ Successfully complete online training courses with respect to the roles and responsibilities of Board members as prescribed by the Act.

**You are not eligible if you are:**

- ◆ A judge or justice of the peace;
- ◆ A member of a police service, special constable, or a First Nation Officer;
- ◆ Someone practicing criminal law (either defense or prosecution);
- ◆ A director, officer, or employee of any policing provider;
- ◆ A former member of a police services unless:
  - ◆ The OPP Detachment Board does not maintain a police service that the person was a member of; and
  - ◆ At least one year has passed since the person ceased to be a member of any police service.

If you live in Temiskaming Shores and would like to support community safety and wellbeing, we invite you to apply.

Appointed members of the Board will receive compensation at a per-diem rate, as well as reimbursement for any Board-related travel costs outside of the community. This opportunity offers a chance to actively participate in shaping local law enforcement and safety initiatives.
