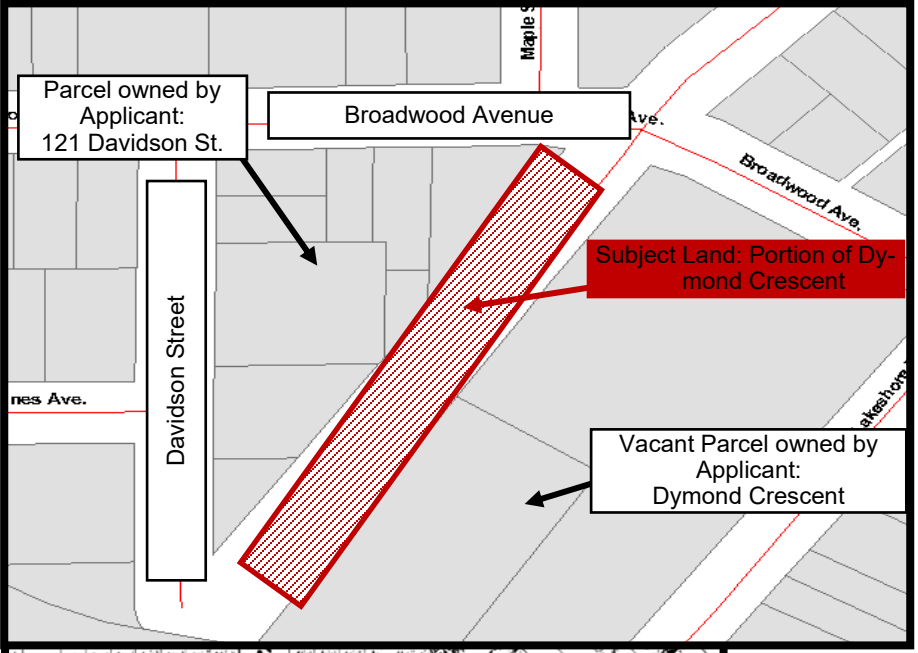

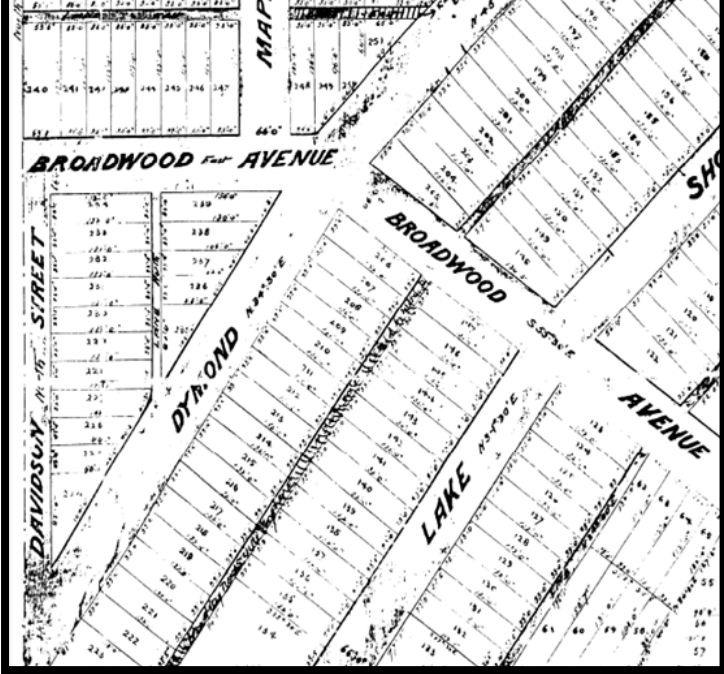

Proponent / Purpose | The owner of 121 Davidson Street and a vacant parcel on Dymond Crescent is seeking to purchase a portion of unopened road allowance on Dymond Crescent, to facilitate the future development of the properties for residential purposes.
