THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF TEMISKAMING SHORES BY-LAW NO. 2013-119 BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2011-138, AS AMENDED, A BY-LAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL OPEN AIR BURNING WITHIN THE CITY OF TEMISKAMING SHORES.

WHEREAS under Section 8 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, the powers of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly to enable it to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS under Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS under Section 10 (1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, a single-tier municipality may provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

AND WHEREAS Council, on October 18, 2011 adopted By-law No. 2011-138, being a new by-law to regulate and control open air burning within the City of Temiskaming Shores and repealed By-law No. 2009-162;

AND WHEREAS Council, on December 4, 2012, adopted By-law No. 2012-156, being a by-law to amend By-law No. 2011-138 to increase the fine for *conducting open air burning in a restricted fire zone or during a fire ban* from \$100 to \$500;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Clerk received a letter from the Regional Senior Justice from the Ontario Court of Justice dated July 11, 2013 with an Order which reduced the fine for conducting open air burning in a restricted fire zone or during a fire ban as adopted by Bylaw 2011-138, from \$500 to \$300;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Temiskaming Shores hereby enacts the following as a by-law:

1. That Item 6 in Appendix "1" to Schedule "A" of By-law No. 2011-138, as amended, be hereby amended as follows:
