Operational Changes – Recycling Facility (547 Barr Drive)

Effective January 1, 2025, the recycling program in the City of Temiskaming Shores will be managed by Circular Materials Ontario (CMO), under the requirements of the Government of Ontario Blue Box Regulation 391/21.

Effective February 1, 2025, the recycling facility located at 547 Barr Drive will be closed for public use. The depot recycling bins currently located outside of this facility will be relocated to the New Liskeard Landfill (704165 Rockley Road). Any excess recyclable material may be deposited for free at this location.

The City of Temiskaming Shores has entered into an agreement with Phippen Waste Management for the lease of the recycling facility located at 547 Barr Drive from February 1, 2025, until April 30, 2025. Industrial, Commercial or Institutional (ICI) owners currently using the facility or depot bins are encouraged to reach out to Phippen Waste Management to make drop-off arrangements.

The City of Temiskaming Shores is investigating options moving forward as the requirements of the Government of Ontario Blue Box Regulation will change how the current recycling program operates. More information will be provided as it becomes available.

Industrial, Commercial and Institutional (ICI) Curbside Recycling Collection

As of January 1, 2025, Temiskaming Shores' recycling program will be managed by Circular Materials Ontario (CMO), under the requirements of the new Provincial Governments Blue Box Regulation 391/21. Within the regulation, CMO is not required to collect from any ICI establishments, however, will allow the ICI material to be mixed with residential material from January 1, 2025 until December 31, 2025.

Please visit the City's website for further information as to how this will affect your establishment should you be part of the current curbside recycling collection program.

The City of Temiskaming Shores is committed to investigating options moving forward as it is recognized that the new Provincial Blue Box Regulation will have financial implications to the ICI establishments currently part of the program.

ICI Water Meter Program

The City of Temiskaming Shores is scheduled to begin its water metering program as of January 1st, 2025. All properties under the water metering program will be subject to water consumption-based utility billing under By-law No. 2024-058 on a quarterly basis. Thank you for your cooperation.

Tips

- ◆ Please remove all objects, including basketball nets from the roadways and sidewalks. Objects obstruct snow removal and could be damaged if left on the roadway or sidewalk
- ◆ Report a problem about snow and or ice online through the Citizen Reporter, located on the City Website.
- ◆ Public Works phone system is now set up for Winter Mode. When you call, 705-647-6220 you will be directed to Public Works between 8:00am - 4:30pm. If busy or after hours the call will automatically transfer to 705-648-5575.
- ◆ For issues in regards to Temiskaming Transit please contact Voyago Operations-Temiskaming Shores directly at 705-230-2751.

Roadway Service Standards

To ensure the safety of drivers and pedestrians, major routes are serviced on a 24/7 basis when necessary and are maintained as bare as possible. Secondary routes are attended to regularly, but less often than Priority routes and are maintained in a snow packed condition.

- ◆ Priority Road Routes plowing will begin once 5cm of snow has accumulated.
- ◆ Secondary Road Route plowing will begin once 8cm of snow has accumulated.

Sidewalk Service Standards

Sidewalks are maintained in a snow packed condition. When possible sidewalk machines start later than plowing operations, for snow removal and disposal, to address snow that may be pushed onto pathways during snow plowing operations. Not all municipal sidewalks are maintained during winter operations.

- ◆ Priority Sidewalk Routes maintenance will begin once 5cm of snow has accumulated.
- ◆ Secondary Sidewalk Routes maintenance will begin once 8cm of snow has accumulated.

Youth Gym Admission Policy | Effective January 1, 2025
 The starting age for the Waterfront Pool & Fitness Centre is 12. There are no exceptions to this rule. All children ages 12-15 who are using the gym must schedule a Facility Orientation with a Trainer on our Orientation Trainer list.
 If you are 12-15 and are a current holder of a gym membership or punch card, your membership will be placed on hold beginning January 1st, 2025 until you can complete an Orientation with one of our listed Trainers. Once completed, your membership will be extended from the days missed.
 For questions or concerns contact the Waterfront Pool and Fitness Centre at 705-647-5709.

How to Schedule an Orientation
 See the Front Desk for a contact of our Facility Orientation Trainers. You are responsible for contacting and scheduling a date to complete your orientation.

Cost of Orientation
 The cost of the Facility Orientation session is \$50.00 and is to be paid directly to the Trainer completing the orientation. The orientation consists of a detailed tour of the facility, guidance on how to use each machine, and proper gym etiquette.

Completion of Orientation
 During the orientation, the Trainer will fill out a checklist. Once complete, the Trainer and a parent or legal guardian must sign off on the completion of your Facility Orientation and liability form.

What to do after an Orientation
 Once you have been signed off, you may purchase a gym membership or a punch card. A punch card must be entered into our computer system. Along with purchasing a membership, all necessary paperwork must be filled out (membership form, Par Q, and liability form).

12-15 Year Old Drop Ins
 Drop ins between the ages of 12-15 are not permitted. You must complete a facility orientation and then purchase a membership or online punch card.

16+ Drop Ins
 If you are 16, you are eligible to enter on a drop-in basis, however you may be required to show proof of age, i.e. Health Card, Student Card, Drivers License.

 Applications for the City of Temiskaming Shores Memorial Bench and Tree Program open January 1, 2025. Leave a lasting memory of a loved one by having a bench installed or tree planted in their name. This is a great way to make a low-cost, lasting impact to our community.
 Fee includes the bench or tree, plaque, engraving, shipping, installation and applicable taxes.
 The application period is from January 1 until April 15 will all installations to take place by September 30. The application form and instructions are available on the city website.

 ♦ Permitted burn times are between the hours of 6:00pm and 8:00am.
