Notice of Public Meeting

In accordance with the City's Notice By-law, notice is hereby given that Council for the City of Temiskaming Shores will be considering a By-law for the establishment of a Municipal Transient Accommodation Tax (MAT) and a Municipal Transient Accommodation Tax Reserve Fund at the February 4th, 2025, Committee of the Whole Meeting at 3:00 p.m., in Council Chambers at City Hall, 325 Farr Drive, Haileybury.

What is being proposed?

Council for the City of Temiskaming Shores is considering the implementation of Municipal Transient Accommodation Tax (MAT). MAT Tax is a tax levied on the purchase of transient accommodations within a municipality. The funds collected through the tax are used to promote tourism and to support tourism-related activities and projects. MAT is governed by Provincial O. Reg. 435/17: Transient Accommodation Tax. The regulation outlines the rules and procedures for the collection and remittance of the tax.

The By-law includes details related to the implementation date, tax rate, and collection from applicable accommodation providers, including exemptions and penalties. The By-law has been developed in accordance with provincial regulations and is consistent with other municipalities in Ontario. Ontario Blue Box Transition - January 1, 2025 Effective January 1, 2025, the recycling program in the City of

Temiskaming Shores will be managed by Circular Materials Ontario (CMO), under the requirements of the Government of Ontario Blue Box Regulation 391/21.

Operational Changes – Recycling Facility (547 Barr Drive) Effective February 1, 2025, the recycling facility located at 547 Barr Drive will be closed for public use. The depot recycling bins currently

located outside of this facility will be relocated to the New Liskeard Landfill (704165 Rockley Road). Any excess recyclable material may be deposited for free at this location.

The City of Temiskaming Shores has entered into an agreement with Phippen Waste Management for the lease of the recycling facility located at 547 Barr Drive from February 1, 2025, until April 30, 2025. Industrial, Commercial or Institutional (ICI) owners currently using the facility or depot bins are encouraged to reach out to Phippen Waste Management to make drop-off arrangements.

Industrial, Commercial and Institutional (ICI) Curbside **Recycling Collection**

Within the regulation, CMO is not required to collect from any ICI establishments, however, will allow the ICI material to be mixed with residential material from January 1, 2025 util December 31, 2025.

Please visit the City's website for further information as to how this will affect your establishment should you be part of the current curbside recycling collection program. The City of Temiskaming Shores is committed to investigating

options moving forward as it is recognized that the new Provincial Blue Box Regulation will have financial implications to the ICI establishments currently part of the program. Should your organization choose to opt out of the suggested r
