Notice to Pet Owners | Fur-Friendly Reminder! Register your pets!

Required | Stoop and Scoop

Every Owner of a Dog, Cat or other Animal shall immediately remove excrement (feces) left by the Animal in the City: on a highway or roadway, in a public park, on any public property, on any private property other than the property of the Owner of the Animal.

Required | Pets Leashed

Animals are not permitted to be off leash or at large within the limits of the City. This includes free roaming cats. Animals not within the Premises of its Owner, or on Private Property shall be on a leash: of not more then two meters in length and held under the Effective Control of a Responsible Pers.

Animal Prohibited Areas | Haileybury Beach, New Liskeard Bach, Algonquin Memorial Beach Park, Rotary Farr Park, Temiskaming Shores Rotary Splash Pad, All Local Schools

Off-Leash Dog Areas | Laroque's Field and Murray Daniels Dog Park Dogs who enter an Off-Leash Dog Area must wear a valid Tag and must not have a history of vicious behaviour.


