

#### CHILDREN 12 & UNDER

#### No Swim Test or Unsuccessful Swim Test

- 1. Will receive an orange wristband upon entry.
- 2. Must be directly supervised in the water at all times by a responsible person (13 years of age or older).

3. Are required to remain in the designated shallow area (beach slide included).

### SUCCESSFUL SWIM TEST

#### Children 12 & Under may choose to take the Swim Test:

 Consisting of a 20m swim (recognizable stroke) completed comfortably, on their front, face in the water without the swimmer placing their feet on the

If successful, swimmers will receive a green wristband gaining access to both the pool slide and designated deep area.

The Lifeguard has final discretion as to the pass or fail of the swim test. They obtain the ability to conduct a swim test and reduce deep area privileges at their discretion.

by a licensed electrician. · Extension cords should be used only as a temporary connection. If permanent






appliances should be plugged directly into an outlet. Ground fault circuit interrupters

· Air conditioners and other heavy

- (GFCIs) should be installed in bathrooms, kitchens, and garages. GFCIs shut off an electrical circuit when it becomes a shock hazard. · Check electrical cords for damage such as fraying
- or nicks. A damaged cord can expose wires and result in a potential shock or fire hazard.
