This shell must be able to steer easily with the sphero mini without tipping over. The shell must also allow a balloon to be easily attached to the back that they must defend. The goal for each participant will be to attempt to pop your opponent's balloon before they pop yours. Last one standing wins.

- ◆ The adjacent accessible spot will be temporarily moved eastward.
- ◆ The sidewalk accessibility ramp will remain open.

Roads Work

Please be advised that Road Work is set to begin within the boundaries of the City of Temiskaming Shores for the 2024 construction season. Please drive cautiously in construction areas and around construction workers. Barricades will be put into place to indicate construction areas.

During this time service disruptions may be in effect, including temporary road closures. The city will provide public notice of service disruptions and construction areas on the city website, social media platforms and local radio. City staff will attempt to post public notices and updates, as soon as possible, as often as possible. However, please note that staff will not be able to post all service disruptions notices.

Fire Services

Burning Permit Required

The Temiskaming Shores Fire Department would like to remind all residents of the following:

- ◆ Before burning, all residents are required to obtain a Burning Permit.
- ◆ Burning Permits are required each year from January 1 to December 31.
- ◆ Burning during the day IS NOT permitted from April 1 until October 31.
- ◆ Permitted burn times are between the hours of 6:00pm and 8:00am.

Permit Fees

- ◆ Annual Permits (Renewal) | \$20.00
- ◆ Annual Permits (New or altered sites) | \$30.00

Clothes Dryer Fire Safety Tips



A leading cause of dryer fires in the home is the **lack of dryer maintenance.**

Install **smoke and carbon monoxide alarms** on every storey of your home.

Test them every month.



How do I keep myself and my loved ones safe?

When Installing...

- Have your dryer installed and serviced by a **qualified technician.**
- If you install your own dryer, **follow the manufacturer's instructions** before installing the dryer vent.



Always...

- **Follow the manufacturer's instructions** regarding the safe use of the dryer.
- **Inspect and clean the lint screen** after each load of laundry. The build-up of lint can lead to a fire. Regularly remove lint from ducts and exhaust vents.
- Regularly **inspect the outdoor vent** to ensure it is unobstructed.
- **Turn the dryer off** if you leave home or when you go to bed.
- Keep the area around the dryer **clear of items** that can burn.
