Public Works Services

City of Temiskaming Shores Winter Operations Plan | 2024-2025

Although winter weather is often random and unpredictable, city snow removal efforts are not. The city is committed to providing a high level of snow removal service throughout the winter season, with consideration to safety, environmental and budget concerns. Your cooperation in helping to keep streets clean and safe is appreciated.

Weather Monitoring Season | October 1, 2024 to April 30, 2025

The minimum standard is to monitor the weather, both current and forecast to occur in the next 24 hours, once every shift or three times per calendar day, whichever is more frequent, at intervals determined by the municipality.

Winter Maintenance Season | On or about November 1, 2024 to April 15, 2025.

The City will perform winter highway maintenance activities including snowplowing, salt and sand application and storage, snow removal and storage, and sidewalk plowing and de-icing.

Roadway Service Standards

The Plan assigns priority to all major roads with the highest traffic in the city. To ensure the safety of drivers and pedestrians, these major routes are serviced on a 24/7 basis when necessary and are maintained as bare as possible. Secondary routes (all residential streets in the city) are attended to regularly, but less often than Priority routes and are maintained in a snow packed condition.

Priority Road Routes plowing will begin once 5cm of snow has accumulated.
Secondary Road Route plowing will begin once 8cm of snow has accumulated.

Sidewalk Service Standards

Sidewalks are classified in accordance with the associated pedestrian traffic and proximity to schools, seniors' buildings, downtown business areas and high-volume roadways. Sidewalks are maintained in a snow packed condition. When possible sidewalk machines start later than plowing operations, for snow removal and disposal, to address snow that may be pushed onto pathways during snow plowing operations. Not all municipal sidewalks are maintained during winter operations.

Priority Sidewalk Routes maintenance will begin once 5cm of snow has accumulated.
Secondary Sidewalk Routes maintenance will begin once 8cm of snow has accumulated.

Work on the Mount Pleasant Cemetery Columbarium foundation is scheduled to occur beginning mid-October 2024.

Proposed End Date

No later than November 8, 2024.
Landscaping and reinstallation of memorial benches: Spring 2025.

Project Details/ Background

Since installation of the Columbarium in 2009, the foundation has begun to heave, creating a gap between the foundation and the structure. There will be excavation on opposite sides of the existing concrete block foundation for work to occur.
The Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO) granted approval of the construction plan.

Temporary Closure During Construction

For the safety of all visitors, once work has commenced, the Columbarium area will be closed to the public for visitation and interments. Please keep a safe distance from equipment and do not enter closed areas.

Fire Services

Butt Out Smoking Fires



Smoking is the #1 cause of **fatal home fires** in Ontario.

Alcohol is a factor in many smoking related fires.

Install **smoke and carbon monoxide alarms** on every storey of your home.

Test them every month.



How do I prevent a smoking fire?

- To prevent smoking fires, **you must be alert.** You will not be alert if you are sleepy, have consumed alcohol, drugs or medicine that makes you drowsy.
- **Never smoke in bed.**
- If people have been smoking in your home, **check behind chair and sofa cushions** for cigarette butts before going to bed.
- Use **large deep ashtrays** that cannot be knocked over.
- Empty ashes into a **metal container**—not the garbage can—and put it outside.
- **Do not extinguish cigarettes in plant pots**, which may contain a mixture of peat moss, shredded wood and bark that can easily ignite.
- Encourage smokers to **smoke outside.**
