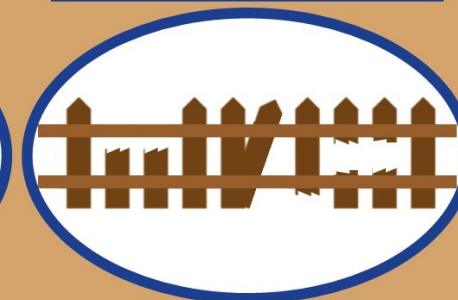


Property Standards Common Code Violations

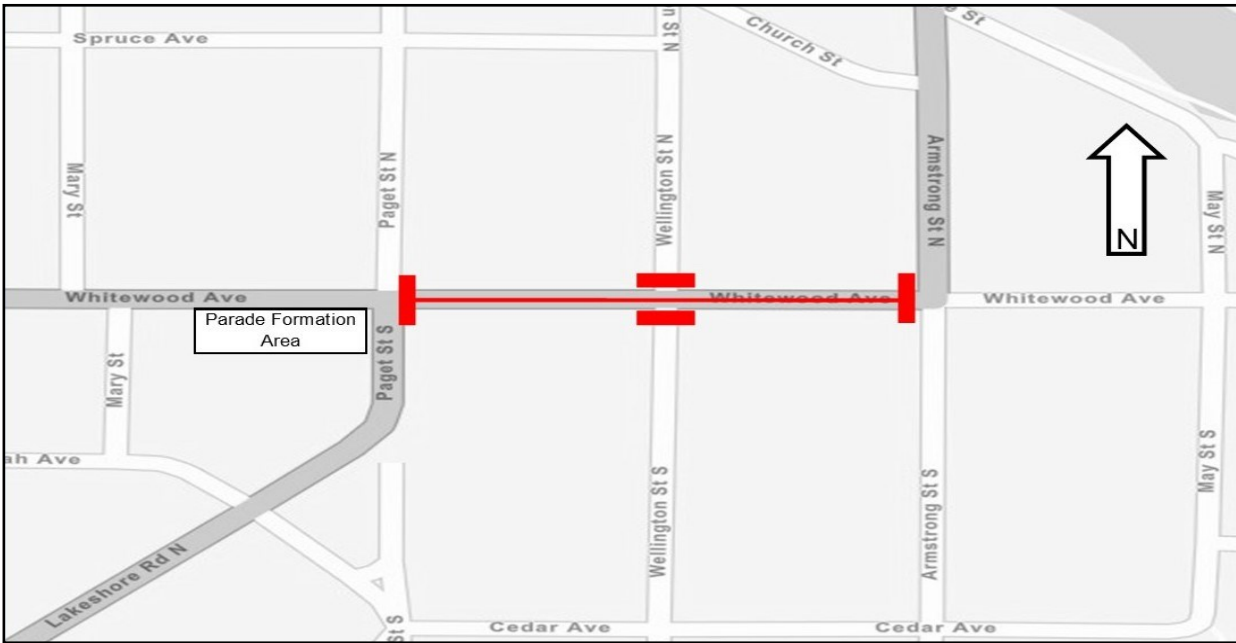

City of Temiskaming Shores Winter Operations Plan | 2024-2025

Although winter weather is often random and unpredictable, city snow removal efforts are not. The city is committed to providing a high level of snow removal service throughout the winter season, with consideration to safety, environmental and budget concerns. Your cooperation in helping to keep streets clean and safe is appreciated.

Weather Monitoring Season | October 1, 2024 to April 30, 2025

The minimum standard is to monitor the weather, both current and forecast to occur in the next 24 hours, once every shift or three times per calendar day, whichever is more frequent, at intervals determined by the municipality.

Winter Maintenance Season | On or about November 1, 2024 to April 15, 2025.

The City will perform winter highway maintenance activities including snowplowing, salt and sand application and storage, snow removal and storage, and sidewalk plowing and de-icing.

Roadway Service Standards

- ♦ Priority Road Routes plowing will begin once 5cm of snow has accumulated.
- ♦ Secondary Road Route plowing will begin once 8cm of snow has accumulated.

Sidewalk Service Standards

- ♦ Priority Sidewalk Routes maintenance will begin once 5cm of snow has accumulated.
- ♦ Secondary Sidewalk Routes maintenance will begin once 8cm of snow has accumulated.

Time to Change your Clocks and the Batteries in all Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Alarms

Clocks will fall backwards one hour at 2am on November 3, 2024, and the Temiskaming Shores Fire Department is recommending residents install new batteries in their smoke and carbon monoxide alarms when they change their clocks.

In order for smoke and carbon monoxide alarms to do their job, they need to have working batteries. Once a year, old batteries should be replaced with new batteries. When you change your clocks on November 3, 2024, the Temiskaming Shores Fire Department wants everyone to take the time to install new batteries in all alarms."

In order to survive a fire, you need to be provided with an early warning and know what to do when the smoke alarms sound. Working smoke alarms are required on every storey of the home and outside all sleeping areas. For added protection, it is recommended to also install smoke alarms inside all bedrooms.

Carbon monoxide alarms must be installed outside all sleeping areas if your home has a fuel-burning appliance, fireplace or attached garage.

Tampering with or removing the batteries from your smoke and carbon monoxide alarms is against the law. Failure to comply with the Fire Code can result in a ticket for \$360 or a fine of up to \$50,000.
