	CO2 Sensor Lending Program Curious about the air quality in your indoor spaces? The library has CO2 Sensors for Ioan. CO2 is a gas that is produced when people exhale. As more people remain in a room, CO2 levels increase quickly if there is not enough fresh air coming into the space. High indoor CO2 levels can cause tiredness, headaches and other symptoms, and indicate that a space is not well ventilated. High CO2 levels can also facilitate the spread of airborne infections. The devices are not CO (Carbon Monoxide) detectors and are not life safety devices.

Winter Operations Plan

City of Temiskaming Shores Winter Operations Plan | 2024-2025

Although winter weather is often random and unpredictable, city snow removal efforts are not. The city is committed to providing a high level of snow removal service throughout the winter season, with consideration to safety, environmental and budget concerns. Your cooperation in helping to keep streets clean and safe is appreciated.

Weather Monitoring Season | October 1, 2024 to April 30, 2025

The minimum standard is to monitor the weather, both current and forecast to occur in the next 24 hours, once every shift or three times per calendar day, whichever is more frequent, at intervals determined by the municipality.

Winter Maintenance Season | On or about November 1, 2024 to April 15, 2025.

The City will perform winter highway maintenance activities including snowplowing, salt and sand application and storage, snow removal and storage, and sidewalk plowing and de-icing.

Roadway Service Standards

- Priority Road Routes plowing will begin once 5cm of snow has accumulated.
- Secondary Road Route plowing will begin once 8cm of snow has accumulated.

Sidewalk Service Standards

- Priority Sidewalk Routes maintenance will begin once 5cm of snow has accumulated.
- Secondary Sidewalk Routes maintenance will begin once 8cm of snow has accumulated.
