City of Temiskaming Shores Winter Operations Plan | 2024-2025

Although winter weather is often random and unpredictable, city snow removal efforts are not. The city is committed to providing a high level of snow removal service throughout the winter season, with consideration to safety, environmental and budget concerns. Your cooperation in helping to keep streets clean and safe is appreciated.

Winter Maintenance Season | On or about November 1, 2024 to April 15, 2025. The City will perform winter highway maintenance activities including snowplowing, salt and sand application and storage, snow removal and storage, and sidewalk plowing and de-icing

Tips

- Please remove all objects, including basketball nets from the roadways and sidewalks. Objects obstruct snow removal and could be damaged if left on the roadway or sidewalk
- Report a problem about snow and or ice online through the Citizen Reporter, located on the City Website.
- Public Works phone system is now set up for Winter Mode. When you call, 705-647-6220 you will be directed to Public Works between 8:00am - 4:30pm. If busy or after hours the call will automatically transfer to 705-648-5575.

Overnight Parking Prohibited | Effective November 1, 2024 to March 31, 2025 By-law No. 2012-101 prohibits the parking of vehicles on municipal streets or City-owned parking lots between the hours of 12:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m.

Please remove vehicles from municipal areas by 11:00 p.m. as Winter Crews begin snow removal.

Service Standards

Priority Road Routes | A maximum level of approx. 5cm of fallen snow is permitted. Secondary Road Routes | A maximum level of approx. 8cm of fallen snow is permitted.

Priority Sidewalk Routes | A maximum level of approx. 5cm of fallen snow is permitted. Secondary Sidewalk Routes | A maximum level of approx. 8cm of fallen snow is permitted.

Note | Not all sidewalks are maintained in the Winter. Sidewalks that are not maintained are considered closed for the season.

Blue Box Transition | Effective January 1, 2025

Transition to an enhanced blue box program is coming to Ontario, which will deliver a convenient, consistent, and effective recycling system that will improve recycling rates.

This transition is managed by Circular Materials—the administrator of the common collection system and a not-for-profit organization committed to building efficient and effective recycling systems in Ontario.

No changes for residents-you will still be able to recycle the same materials, and your collection day does not change!
